**Over/Under Split:** based on age at time of sign-up. 15 years of age and under = **Under Class**, 16 years of age and older = **Over Class**

<b>Amateur:</b> for Novice (C) or Intermediate (B) rank riders	<b>Expert:</b> for Expert (A) or Master (AA) rank riders
<b>Veteran:</b> for riders 30-39 years of age at sign-up	<b>Senior:</b> for riders aged 40-49 years of age at sign-up
<b>Super Senior:</b> for riders 50 years or older at sign-up	

- Series points are awarded only to registered license holders based on date of purchase to the end of the Off-Road Series, not retroactive.
- Riders may change classes upwards by applying for a new license. Riders will not be allowed to complete in their old class.
- For riders competing in US events please ensure that you are racing in the correct class. Your overall points will be affected.
