Learnings and questions: A race for very young/inexperienced individuals may require exceptions, such as adjustment to course and time. PeeWee is to be a "D" course only, new courses are not required of clubs. However, clubs may make adjustments if needed. Ex.: "Little" D's race separate from "Big" D's.
